

GRAND RAPIDS TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

February 13, 2017

The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 P.M. in the Grand Rapids Fire Hall. Roll call was answered by Rita Foos, Eric Flora and Tracy Punches. There were three guests present.

Eric Flora moved to approve the minutes and dispense with reading the minutes of the previous meeting as copies were made available to guests. 2nd by Rita Foos. Roll Call YES: Eric Flora, Rita Foos and Tracy Punches. Motion carried.

Bills in the amount of \$14,419.14 were presented for approval by the Fiscal Officer. Tracy Punches moved to pay all bills as presented. 2nd by Rita Foos. Roll Call YES: Rita Foos, Eric Flora and Tracy Punches. Motion carried.

Cary Long reported fire runs 7-17.

Gary Haas informed the board that the catch basins were jettied out and that there is a problem with one of the tiles that is in Henry County.

Rita Foos asked why the trees in the cemetery were cut down and who decided to have them cut down. Tracy Punches said they were removed to prevent their roots from getting into the drainage tiles. Eric Flora said that the decision was made by the prior board and it was generally agreed by the board to have the trees removed.

Rita Foos asked if the typos in the Zoning Resolution would be updated when the Zoning Commission updates the Zoning Resolution. Rita Foos also asked Eric Flora how the Ambulance District has been running. Eric Flora stated that the Ambulance District has been running good, they have the same crew operating the district and they are doing a good job. He also mentioned that the district is currently getting set up to bill Medicare and Medicaid.

Rita Foos informed the board that she will be late to the next meeting because she has to attend the Village Council Meeting on behalf of the Grand Rapids Arts Council.

Appropriations were passed out and reviewed by the Board.
